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- Material must be stacked adjacent to roads and accessible to our contractor's equipment without having to be moved. All butt ends facing the road.
 - Material must be free of rocks, dirt, berry vines, poison oak, oleander, tree stumps or construction materials of any type.
 - Brush, tree limbs and trees smaller than 6 inches in diameter must be stacked neatly.
 - Material must be cut to manageable 12 foot lengths maximum.
 - Piles cannot exceed 5 feet in height.
 - Bulldozed piles or machine stacked piles cannot be processed. Piles cross stacked or stacked too densely or compacted will not be chipped.

Applicant must send in the South Lake Fire Safe Council Annual Membership Application Form and a donation of \$30.00 with your first chipping request each year. This yearly donation will be applied to the first half (1/2) hour of chipping per year. Members will be charged \$30 for each half hour of chipping thereafter for a total of no more than four (4) hours chipping per year. Applicant agrees to pay South Lake Fire Safe Council for additional chipping not covered by the \$30 membership donation within 15 days of billing.
