 Brush, tree limbs and trees must be smaller than 6 inches in diameter and no longer than 12 feet. Piles cannot exceed 5 feet in height and must be stacked neatly Material must be stacked adjacent to roads and accessible to our contractor's equipment without having to be moved. All cut ends facing the road. Material must be free of rocks, dirt, berry vines, poison oak, oleander, tree stumps or construction materials of any type. Bulldozed piles or machine stacked piles cannot be processed. Piles cross stacked or stacked too densely or compacted will not be chipped. Property Address must be clearly visible, where piles are located. Material must be stacked so that traffic is not impacted and crews can work safely. Please allow for safe ingress and egress when setting up your piles.
Applicant must send in the <u>South Lake Fire Safe Council Annual Membership Application Form</u> and a payment of \$30.00, for the year, with your first chipping. Subsequent requests for chipping during the same year require ner request for chipping form and right of entry form. Mail Forms to P. O. Box 1773, Middletown, CA 95461. Donations appreciated.
